The picture is a picture of the Choulteca Bridge in Honduras. The bridge was engineered to withstand a category 5 hurricane. In 1998, Hurricane Mitch slammed into Honduras and the engineering proved correct. The bridge still stood. But, do you notice a problem with the picture above? Hurricane Mitch was so forceful the river moved! The bridge was perfectly built, but

the landscape changed and now the bridge isn't serving the purpose it was established. I first heard this illustration at a Pastor's conference a few years ago relating to our world around us. The river moved. Our culture has changed dramatically. According to Pew Research and Barna Group, organizations that study the influence of religion in America there are some startling statistics about the church's decline in attendance. Today, less than 20% of American regularly attends church. 85% of churches are declining or plateauing. By 2050, the percentage of the US population attending church will be ½ of what it was in 1990. You can probably even think of some people who are close to you who don't know Jesus and have no desire to, perhaps even people that you helped bring up in the church. This is tough to think about, but the river has moved. It can be a scary thought.

But, there is good news, Jesus is still Lord! He is still the head of His Church! One of my favorite bible verses deals with Jesus and Zacchaeus. Jesus goes out of his way to find Zacchaeus, a notorious sinner outside of the people of God. He stays at his house and leads Zacchaeus to follow Him. And at the end of this encounter, Jesus says "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." (Luke 19:10) Seeking and saving the lost, this is what Jesus does! He uses us to be part of this. As the river has moved around us, he will use His Church to cross it. So what does that mean? He uses us to build upon the foundation laid out in Scripture to be a part of his plan to seek and to save those around us. This is what we'll be focusing on. Where is Jesus leading us? How is He going to use you at Grace Lutheran Church to follow him to build upon our bridge to reach people!

I know that He has great things in store for us. As we keep looking back to His Word for direction, he will shape us to truly seek and save the lost. I look forward to working with you on this journey!


